Woodfield Pool Rules

Pool Hours: Monday through Sunday, 9:00am - 9:00pm 2017 Pool Season: Saturday, May 27th to Monday, September 4th

Woodfield has established the following rules for use of the community pool. It is the responsibility of each resident to enforce and obey these rules. During the busiest times of the year, there will be a pool monitor on site to hold residents more accountable to these rules. In the event of any of these rules being broken, pool privileges will be revoked for a period decided by the board.

- 1. Please be considerate of other residents when inviting guests to use the pool. No more than **two (2)** guests per household should be at the pool. A resident of the community must accompany guests at all times. The pool cannot be reserved by a resident; all residents must have equal access to the pool during normal operating hours.
- 2. Children under the age of **fourteen (14)** are to be accompanied by a responsible adult (<u>must be age 18 or older</u>), as required by the Indiana Health Department. This has been an issue with allowing a 16 year old to supervise their younger siblings. There have also been issues of parents leaving young children at the pool unsupervised while the parent is in the parking lot. These issues will be watched closely and this rule will be strictly enforced. This rule exists for safety, to limit the HOA liability, and to ensure the pool is enjoyable for residents of all ages.
- 3. A Lifeguard is not required and will not be present during open hours. Anyone using the pool does so at his or her own risk.
- 4. There will be an attendant provided who is responsible for monitoring check-in procedures of residents. This is **NOT** a lifeguard. They will also check bathrooms on a regular basis and make decisions regarding the health and wellbeing of those in the pool. This includes any decisions related to closing the pool.
- 5. Absolutely **NO** pool furniture in the pool or the baby pool. This is serious safety issue and causes damage to the pool and the furniture.
- 6. Each resident must access the pool with their own pool key. Do not open the gate and allow access to the pool to any person not in possession of their pool key. If a resident with a working key is found to allow a neighbor to use their key for any reason, their pool access will be terminated for the remainder of the season.
- 7. Pets are **NOT** allowed in the pool area, especially in the pool.
- 8. No street clothes or disposable diapers allowed in the pool.
- 9. No running, pushing, or rowdy horseplay will be tolerated.
- 10. No playing on the ladders or float line. No throwing hard objects (Frisbees, balls, etc.) in pool.

12. **NO DIVING**.

- 13. No smoking in pool area. Please be considerate and do not toss cigarette butts in the common areas, throw them away.
- **14. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. NO GLASS** allowed on pool deck. Food and drink allowed in deck area; trash must be placed in proper receptacles.
- 15. When lightening is sighted, the pool area must be evacuated.
- 16. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles, accidents or injuries.
